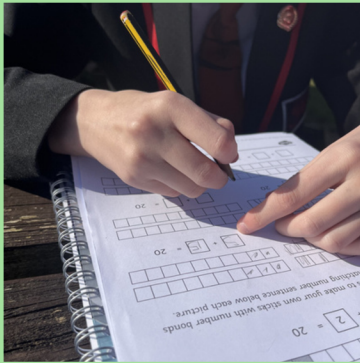


TERM FOUR
