### Uniform

Our high expectations and values for students, in all aspects of their education, are certainly extended to their uniform. We consider all students wearing the uniform, as ambassadors for the school. Severn Vale School has a set uniform which must be worn by all students.

- A school blazer.
- A school tie – Each Year group has a different coloured tie. **Year 7 ties will be green next year – they will be handed out in September. Students will arrive at school without a tie on their first day. Ties cost £6 which will be paid via the parent pay account.**
- Plain white work-style shirt– long or short-sleeved.
- Either tailored black trousers, or the school skirt (only the skirt approved by the school and provided by our uniform supplier). Trousers should be plain black and tailored. No “fashion” extremes will be tolerated (tight, stretchy, low rise, chinos, jeans, drainpipe, Miss Sixty, linen, leggings or cropped).
- Plain black shoes. No canvas shoes, trainers or trainer style shoes. Please note the school’s decision on what constitutes a shoe is final. If in doubt, please check with the school before purchasing any new shoes.
- A V-necked jumper can be purchased from our uniform suppliers. This is optional and can be worn under the blazer, but not instead of a blazer.
- Plain black socks. Tights should be plain black and not patterned.
- During cold/wet weather, students are encouraged to wear an outside, waterproof coat for the journey to and from school and during break time and lunchtime. Please note that denim / leather jackets and hoodies are NOT permitted.

There are also clear expectations for Hair, Make-up and Nails which can be found on the school website following the link above.

Our behaviour policy is used to maintain our high expectations with regards to uniform – details of which can be found on the school website. Special dispensation can be granted due to medical needs – however this must be supported by an appropriate medical note.

If your child currently receives free school meals they may be eligible for a school uniform grant – an application form for the grant is available on the school website using the link above.

Friends of Severn Vale have stocks of second-hand uniform. Further details regarding opportunities to buy this will follow.

## **School Bag**

Every student should have a school bag in which books and equipment can be carried. Small, clutch hand bags are not suitable for school use.

## **Equipment**

Things students need to bring every day

- Pencil Case
- Two black or blue pens (Year 7 Students will receive an SVS pen on 2<sup>nd</sup> September.)
- Two sharp pencils
- Ruler
- Pencil sharpener
- Rubber
- Scientific calculator
- Protractor
- Set of coloured pencils
- Reading book (either from home or from the LRC at school)
- Exercise books for the day
- All homework due
- Water bottle - reusable

Some days students will need extra equipment/kit. This will depend on the lessons they have each day. They need to check their timetable and work out the additional equipment they need each day.

There is a locker system available at Severn Vale School in September. Further details will follow.
