To update you with the transition process, over the fortnight beginning 9th June 2025 Beth Kilpatrick, the Head of Year 7, Ali Jones, the Year 7 Pastoral Mentor and I will be visiting some of our primary schools.

We are really looking forward to meeting the students and answering any questions they have about Severn Vale School. During the visits we will be launching the *Be Awesome/Go Big project* with the students. This is a Year 6/7 transition project which was designed to support students' transition to secondary school. The project runs across 9 sessions which can be followed by students at home. The project can be supported by the books *Be Awesome* and *Go big*, however these are not essential.
