

Secondary School Uniform Grant

School Uniform Grant

Students from low-income families transferring to secondary education (i.e. into Year 7) are entitled to support with their uniform costs.

Severn Vale School also accept Uniform Grant Application Forms for students moving into Year 10.

Assistance with Locker Rental Fee

Severn Vale School also give assistance towards the annual locker rental fee to those eligible for Uniform Grant. The voucher code offered will cover half of the annual rental fee.

Who is eligible?

If your child is transferring into Year 7 (from Primary to Secondary School) in September or moving up within the school from Year 9 to Year 10 and is currently receiving Free School Meals (FSM), they may be entitled to a school uniform grant.

The grant is paid as a contribution towards the cost of your child's school uniform. Successful applications will be issued with a voucher that can be redeemed at the Monkhouse Schoolwear Shop, 99 Northgate Street, Gloucester as the stockist of our school uniform. The voucher may be used to buy any item of clothing that is on your child's required uniform list.

The grant is a one-off payment and does not need to be paid back. However, if it is found that a grant has been claimed fraudulently then we will require the full amount of the grant to be returned. The voucher is valid for 6 months from the date of issue. The voucher is not transferrable, so cannot be sold or given to another family.

How does it work?

Once you have filed out your application form, you need to return it to the school's reception for the attention of Finance. Alternatively, you can email your completed form to finance@severnvaeschool.com

How long does it take?

We will try to respond to applications within 10 school days. If you are entitled to a grant, you will receive a letter confirming this accompanied by the voucher.

When can I apply?

Applications are available from now to purchase uniform for the September that your child transfers from Primary to Secondary school or moves from Year 9 to Year 10. Please note, we may be unable to process grant applications during the school holiday periods.

Please return by Friday 3rd July 2026 in order for the application to be processed before the summer break.
